Space, Access, and Equipment Requirements:

- Equipment is delivered in a 12' box truck (22' long x 10' tall) with lift gate that needs access to the location of the demonstration. We need a level path to the demonstration area. Although the furnace is on wheels, it is heavy and requires a solid, level surface.
- In addition to the truck, the demonstration alone requires 300 sq. ft which includes space for the $44'' \times 44''$ furnace and a 10' x 15' tent.
- Preferred access to 120v power within 30ft.
- The demonstration runs on a 100lb propane cylinder that arrives on site in the truck.
- The operation of the furnace requires an open flame and a running temperature of 2000°F.
- Glassblowers need to see the glass. If the event is after dark, Hot Wheels needs adequate light directly in the space of the mobile furnace.

Security:

• For multi-day bookings we prefer that the site has 24-hour security. If you are booking Hot Wheels for more than one day, you must inform us if 24-hour security is not available.

Sample Timeline:

- Set up and heat up: 4 hours | Demonstration: 3 hours | Clean up and cool down: 3 hours
- 9:00-9:30am—Arrival and set-up
- 1:00pm—Demonstrations begin
- 4:00pm—Clean up and cool down
- 7:00pm—Leave demo site

Cost:

- \$1000 for a three-hour demonstration (includes mileage inside a 20-mile radius of the 15206 zip code)
- \$150 each additional demonstration hour
- Partial or full grant funding is available for select non-profit events; please inquire for details.
